Attire: wear your Dolce Strings blue t-shirt and jeans (blue or black pants), sneakers or closed-toe shoes. (no flip-flops please)

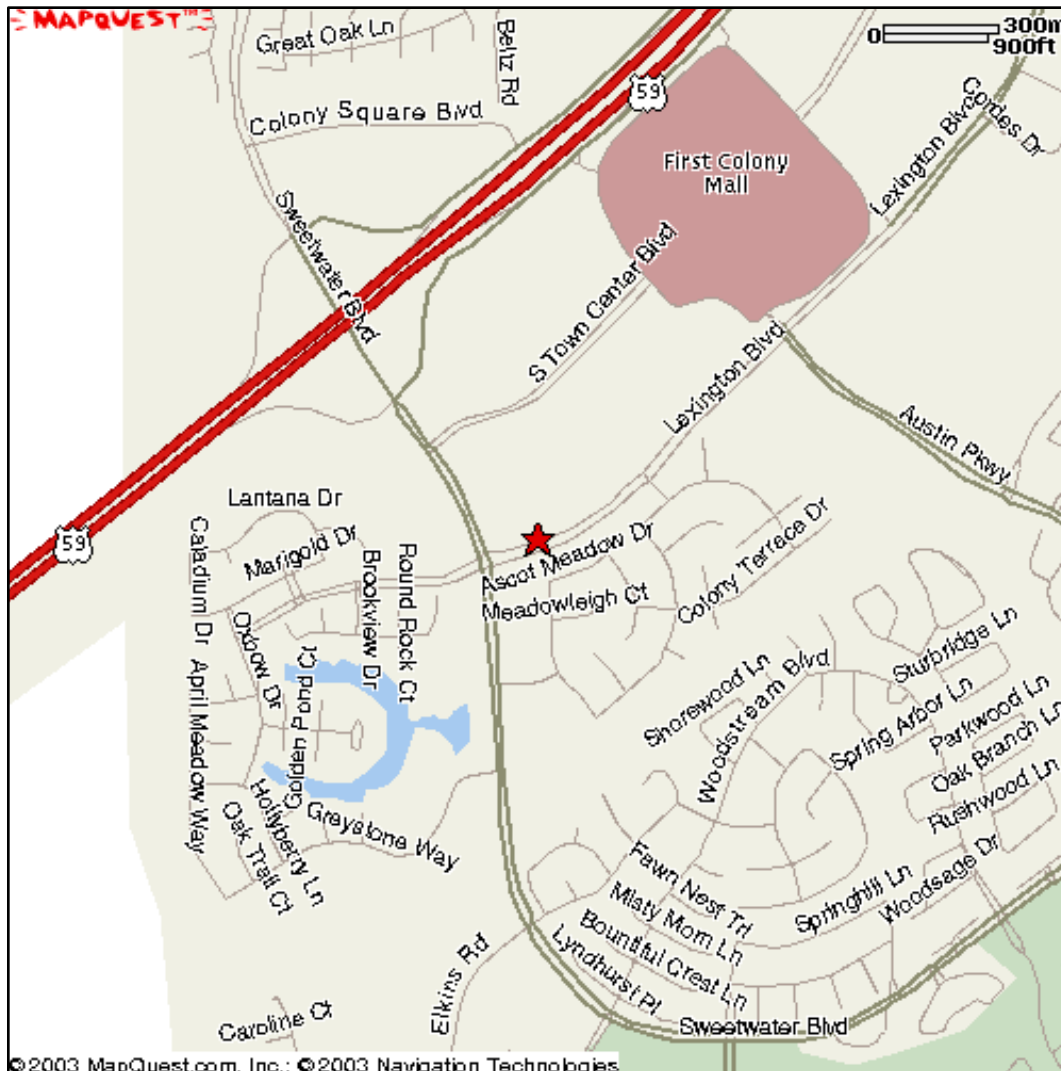
Bring: you, your instrument and bow.
